



- Environmental Strategy 2030
- Long-term Low Carbon
 Strategy 2030/2050
- Adaptation Strategy



Environmental Strategy 2030

- To be adopted by the end of 2018
- Modern vision for better environment and sustainable circular economy
- Priorities: waste, air quality and protection of forest ecosystems
- Climate change:
 - Increase of non-ETS target to -20 % (comp. 2005)
 - Switch from fossil fuels to alternative fuels in transport
 - End of environmentally harmful subsidies
 - Green infrastructure
 - Local adaptation strategies



Long-term Low Carbon Strategy 2030/2050

- To be adopted by the end of 2019
- Cooperation with the World Bank:
 - A low carbon study
 - Macro and energy models with technical documentation
 - Capacity Building
- A low carbon strategy will:
 - provide long term vision of a Slovak low carbon future,
 - align Slovak policies with the Paris Agreement,
 - set new Slovak goals and policies to achieve them and ensure financing.



Adaptation Strategy

- Adopted in March 2014
- Update of Adaptation Strategy adopted in October 2018
- The main objective:
 - provide information on adverse impacts of climate change in different areas and sectors,
 - provide a general guidance on adaptation and propose suitable adaptation measures and actions, a coordination framework for their implementation,
 - increase awareness about climate change.
- Number of areas: geology, soil, water management, biodiversity protection, built environment, public health, agriculture, forestry, transport, tourism, industry and energy.
- Preparation of the national adaptation action plan (NAP) started in April 2018
- National project "Improvement of information and advice on improving the quality of the environment in Slovakia,"
 - Activity on climate adaptation and risk management
